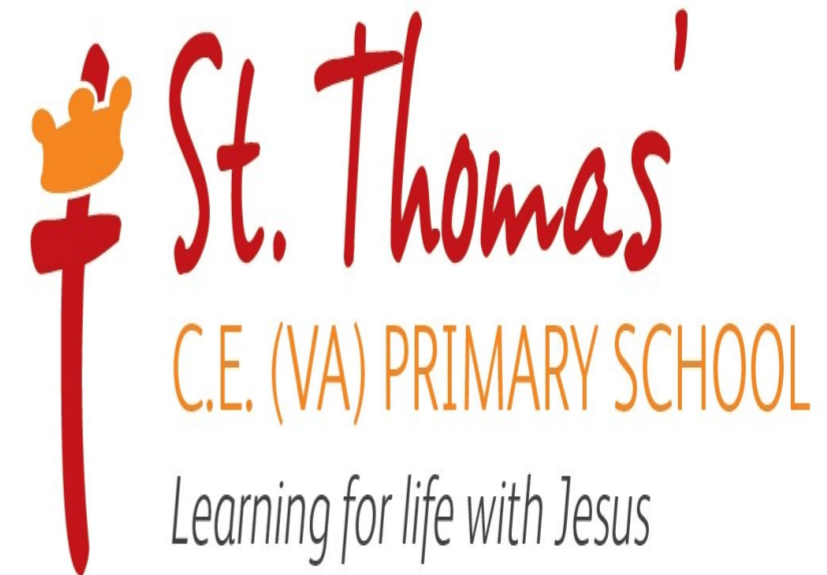

## The School will:

- Provide a broad, balanced and inclusive curriculum in accordance with the school's Christian ethos and mission statement.
- Maintain an open and welcoming ethos fostering a positive relationship with parents and families.
- Promote high standards of behaviour following the example of Jesus, supported by our Golden Rules.
- Plan, set and mark work to maximise motivation and progress for individuals.
- Maintain clear lines of communication with all stakeholders involved in the learning progress.
- Plan, set and mark homework at an age appropriate level for each child.
- Inform parents and carers of their child's progress at regular intervals and in an annual report.
- Enable parents to access learning and progress information electronically as school technology and staff training allows.
- Keep parents informed about activities and events through regular newsletters, information leaflets and messages.
- Maintain robust safeguarding policies and procedures to protect the welfare of all children.
- Undertake systematic, robust and effective self evaluation involving all stakeholders as appropriate for overall school improvement.
- Listen to and respond to concerns or complaints in accordance with school's complaints procedure.

## The Family will:

- Make sure child attends regularly and arrives in school between 8:45am and 8:50am.
- Complete all documentation that supports the school's safeguarding policies eg annual medical forms, basic contact information and consent forms.
- Inform school of changes to medical or personal information.
- Raise any concerns or problems in the first instance with the class teacher.
- Provide child with an in date inhaler if diagnosed asthmatic and complete care plan.
- Contact school by 9:30am on the first morning of absence.
- Avoid taking holidays in term time.
- Attend parents evenings to discuss child's progress.
- Support the school's policies for behaviour and routines.
- Ensure child wears the correct school uniform and that all items are named.
- Ensure child has a water bottle daily.
- Ensure correct P.E. kit is available for lessons.
- Encourage the completion of homework to a good standard, supporting as appropriate.
- Endeavour to read and respond as appropriate to all correspondence sent from school.
